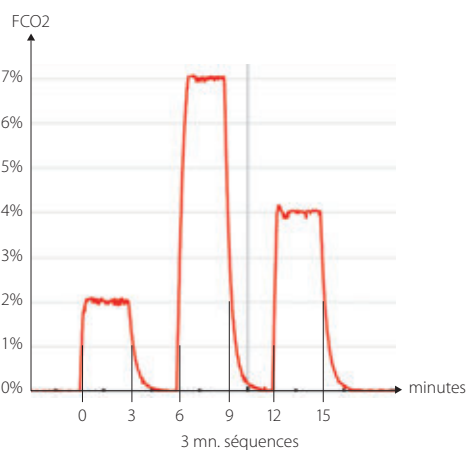


VarioCap

MR-COMPATIBLE NORMOBARIC AIR/CO2 MIXER FOR HYPERCAPNIC VASOREACTIVITY STUDIES ON HUMANS

- Gas mixture produced:
Air + CO₂. CO₂ fraction (FCO₂) can be customised at demand and modified quickly. Remote control from computer placed in the control room. Can be synchronized to the MRI scanner by trigger signal. Hypoxia condition available on request.
- The subject breathes the gas mixture through a mask directly connected to VarioCap. VarioCap is placed near the MRI patient bore so as to minimize the tubing length.
- Sequences of FCO₂ values can be programmed and synchronized to MRI acquisition using the MRI scanner trigger signal.



- VarioCap must be supplied with CO₂ (bottle) and air gas. The gas bottles are placed outside the magnet chamber. VarioCap can be connected to the remote control computer using USB port (via Optical fiber extender).
